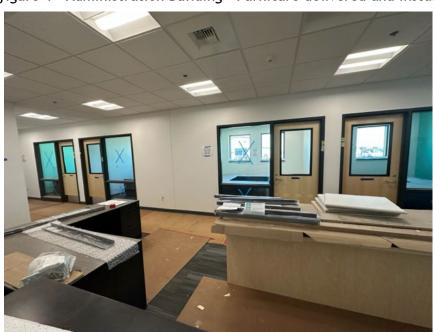


figure 4 - Administration Building - Furniture delivered and installed

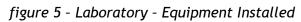




figure 6 - Maintenance Building - HVAC Install

1. DISCUSSION ITEMS

Continuation of contract with Granberg & Associates with monthly earning capped at \$15,000

2. DISCUSSION

In July the Board appointed a new General Manager to the SRWA, as outlined in the General Manager Service Agreement. At that time the Board did not act to terminate the SRWA contract with Granberg & Associates for General Manager services.

As construction nears completion, staff has been working to determine which activities must be carried out by the General Manager, and which may be delegated. In some instances, a person has to be designated as the "responsible person" for signature purposes. Changing that designation at this time will likely take longer than the remaining construction.

We therefore recommend retaining Granberg & Associates for the remainder of construction and commissioning, with limited responsibilities and duties. We further recommend that given the reduction in those duties and responsibilities, the monthly earning potential of Mr. Granberg be capped at \$15,000.

3. FISCAL IMPACT / BUDGET AMENDMENT:

At this time, Construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of September, with Acceptance Testing to be completed by the end of October. That would mean a maximum financial impact of \$45,000, assuming there are no delays. If circumstances should require, the item can be brought back to the Board for further consideration.

4. GENERAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS:

Mr. Granberg has been an integral part of sheperding this vital project to the point where we find it at this time. The General Manager, with counsel and advice from key staff members, recommends the Board take this action to retain Granberg & Associates through commissioning and acceptance.



ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

N/A. This item does not constitute a project under CEQA.

5. ALTERNATIVES:

The SRWA board could choose not to vote to approve the continuation of the Granberg & Associates contract as outlined. Staff does not recommend this course of action.
