The SRWA currently has an unexpended cash balance of just under \$2.5 million. Board authorized property acquisitions totaling approximately \$2.2 million are anticipated to be completed over the next three months consuming most of the available cash. Invoices are being prepared to be sent to the participating agencies in the next couple weeks for the balance of current fiscal year operating expenditures. At the June Board meeting, staff will be presenting a fiscal year 2020/21 budget consisting of anticipated annual operating expenditures and Design-Build contract costs with projected monthly drawdown estimates. At this time, it is anticipated the participating agencies will be invoiced on a quarterly basis as has been done previously to date.

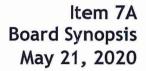

2. DISCUSSION OF ISSUE:

On March 1, 2018, the SRWA approved an agreement with C. Overaa & Co. for construction of the Raw Water Pump Station, Phase 1 Project in an amount of \$6,634,000. The project was deemed substantially complete on February 25, 2020, and final completion was reached on April 5, 2020. There were a total of seven (7) contract change orders that increased the contract amount by \$438,071.00 and extended the contract time by twenty-one (21) calendar days.

There are no known unresolved or outstanding claims against the SRWA. The project specifications require the SRWA and C. Overaa & Co. to sign a Final Closeout Agreement and Release of Claims (attached), which documents all contract changes and release of claims against the SRWA. Following Board approval of the Agreement and Release and acceptance of the completed work, staff will prepare and file a notice of completion with the Stanislaus County Recorder, beginning the 30-day lien release period. Provided there are no stop notice claims or liens filed against the project, the SRWA will release retention securities to C. Overaa & Co. after the expiration of 35 days.

3. FISCAL IMPACT / BUDGET AMENDMENT:

By approving this Agreement and Release, the SRWA will make final payment to C. Overaa & Co. in the amount of \$133,458.85 which, after all other previous contract payments, is 100% of the contract value of \$7,072,071. The total project cost is \$225,329 below the appropriated budget of \$7,297,400. All remaining appropriated funds will be returned to unappropriated fund balance.

FINAL CLOSEOUT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS

THIS FINAL CLOSEOUT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS, hereinafter referred to as "Agreement and Release", is made and effective this 21st day of May, 2020 by and between the Stanislaus Regional Water Authority, hereinafter referred to as "Owner"; and C. Overaa & Co. hereinafter referred to as "Contractor'.

IT IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED AND MUTUALLY AGREED BETWEEN THE OWNER AND CONTRACTOR AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Owner and Contractor entered into an Agreement (the "Principal Agreement") dated March 1, 2018, whereby Contractor was to construct Project described as SRWA Raw Water Pump Station, Phase 1. Pursuant to the terms of said Agreement, the Owner was to pay Contractor the lump sum of \$6,634,000 and to complete performance of said Agreement within a period of Original 700 Calendar Days, to wit: March, 15, 2020 subject only to modification as set forth in written change orders between the parties.
- 2. The Owner and Contractor hereby agree that the Project has been completed by Contractor and this Agreement and Release sets forth all relevant facts pertaining to the respective rights and obligations of the parties for the termination of the Principal Agreement.
- 3. The Owner and Contractor agree the final adjusted Contract price, time of performance and balance payment due to Contractor for said Stanislaus Regional Water Authority Raw Water Pump Station, Phase 1 Project is determined as follows:

4. That subject to the provisions of this Agreement and Release, Owner will forthwith pay to Contractor the sum of \$133,458 Dollars and 85 Cents (\$133,458.85) under the Contract, less any amounts withheld under the Contract or represented by any Notice to Withhold Funds on file with Owner as of the date of such payment. The retention amount held by the Owner will be released to Contractor at the expiration of the lien period plus five days (for a total of thirty-five (35) calendar days after recording a Notice of Completion by the Owner in the office of the County Recorder).

As a condition precedent to such payment being due, the Contractor shall provide the Owner with unconditional waivers and releases upon final payment from each Subcontractor and Supplier providing Work under the Contract (per Civil Code section 8138) and a conditional or unconditional waiver and release upon final payment on behalf of the Contractor (per Civil Code sections 8136 and 8138), in a sum not greater than the amount due so as to enable Owner to make the payment. The amounts withheld by Owner pursuant to stop notices will be released in accordance with agreement of the parties, orders of a court, posting of stop notice release bonds, in compliance with statutory legal procedures, or upon presentation of stop notice releases. Notwithstanding the aforementioned mutual releases, nothing contained this Agreement and Release shall waive or alter the rights, obligations, privileges and powers of the Owner or the duties, liabilities and obligations of the Contractor and its surety under this Contract and/or California law, including in respect to Contractor's Warranty nor with respect to other warranties made by Contractor; nor shall anything contained herein waive rights relating to claims by Owner pertaining to or arising from latent defects, indemnity, or negligent or intentional misrepresentations on the part of the Contractor. Contractor further represents that pursuant to the Contract, the Payment and Performance Bonds obtained for the Project shall remain in effect through the warranty period. Upon acceptance of the Project by the Owner, and execution of this Agreement and Release, the Owner agrees to immediately file and record a Notice of Completion with the County Recorder in order to begin the running of the statutory lien period.

- 5. The Contractor acknowledges and hereby agrees that there are no unresolved or outstanding claims in dispute against Owner arising from the Contract, except for the claims described in paragraph 6 below. It is the intention of the parties in executing this Agreement and Release that this Agreement and Release shall be effective as a full, final and general release of all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, obligations, costs, expenses, damages, losses and liabilities of Contractor against the Owner, and all if its agents, employees, consultants, inspectors, representatives, assignees and transferees, except for the Disputed Claims set forth in paragraph 6 below.
- 6. The following claims (if any) submitted under Section 00700, GENERAL CONDITIONS continue to be disputed (hereinafter, the "Disputed Claims") and are specifically excluded from the operation of this Agreement and Release:

- 7. Consistent with California Public Contract Code Section 7100, Contractor hereby agrees that in consideration of the payment set forth in paragraph 3 above, Contractor hereby releases and forever discharges Owner, and all of its agents, employees, consultants, inspectors, assignees and transferees from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions or causes of action of whatever kind or nature arising out of or in any way concerned with the Work under the Contract, except for the Disputed Claims (if any) set forth in paragraph 6 above.
- 8. That Contractor hereby waives the provisions of California Civil Code Section 1542, which provide as follows:

A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him or her, must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor.

- 9. The provisions of this Agreement and Release are contractual in nature and not mere recitals and shall be considered independent and severable, and if any such provision or any part thereof shall be at any time held invalid in whole or in part under any federal, state, county, municipal or other law, ruling, or regulation, then such provision, or part thereof shall remain in force and effect only to the extent permitted by law, and the remaining provisions of this Agreement and Release shall also remain in full force and effect, and shall, be enforceable.
- 10. The Contractor represents and warrants that it is the true and lawful owner of all claims and other matters released pursuant to this Agreement and Release, and that it has full right, title and authority to enter into this Agreement. Each party represents and warrants that it has been represented by counsel of its own choosing in connection with this Agreement and Release.
- 11. All rights of Owner shall survive completion of the Work or termination of the Contract, and execution of this Agreement and Release.

The undersigned acknowledge and represent that they have read this Agreement and Release in full, and understand and voluntarily consent and agree to each and every provision contained herein. The undersigned further declare and represent that no promise, inducement or agreement, not herein expressed, has been made to the undersigned and that this Agreement and Release contains the entire agreement among the parties hereto and the terms of this Agreement and Release are contractual. The persons executing this Agreement and Release represents and warrants to the other party that the execution and performance of the terms of this Agreement and Release have been duly authorized by all requisite corporate, partnership, individual, or other entity requirements and that said persons have the rights, power and legal capacity and authority to execute and enter into this Agreement and Release.
